



Lorraine Carli is vice president of Outreach and Advocacy for the National Fire Protection Association where she oversees all media and public affairs activities, editorial content for NFPA's Web sites, the organization's magazine NFPA Journal, NFPA's Wildland Fire Operations and Public Education Divisions.

Along with serving as president of the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition, Carli is a member of the Board of Directors for both The Phoenix Society for Burn Survivors and Electric Safety Foundation International (ESFI) and now The Center for Campus Fire Safety.

Prior to joining NFPA, Carli was a public relations consultant working with health care, medical technology, government, and non-profit organizations.
