NFPA® "WHAT KIND OF COOK ARE YOU IN THE KITCHEN? QUIZ" SWEEPSTAKES

Official Rules

By participating in this Sweepstakes, entrants accept and agree to be bound by the following Official Rules:

- 1. NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER THIS SWEEPSTAKES. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. THE ODDS OF WINNING A SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE DEPENDS ON THE NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE ENTRIES RECEIVED.
- **2. SPONSOR & ADMINISTRATOR**. The NFPA "What Kind of Cook are you in the Kitchen Quiz" Sweepstakes (the Sweepstakes) is sponsored and administered by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), One Batterymarch Park, Quincy, Massachusetts 02169-7471, and The Center for Campus Fire Safety (CCFS), 10 State Street, Newburyport, Massachusetts 01950 (each of NFPA, and CCFS individually and collectively, the Sponsor).
- **3. BACKGROUND**. The Sweepstakes helps to raise awareness among college-aged students who live in on- and off-campus housing about the dangers of cooking fires. Students who have access to kitchens and make meals using stoves and ovens have the opportunity to recognize unsafe practices and learn the appropriate way to cook meals that will reduce the risk for injuries and damage caused by fire.
- **4. ELIGIBILITY.** Eligibility for the Sweepstakes is open to natural persons who are legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia and who are (18) years of age and older and are enrolled in an institute of higher learning and have an e-mail address with a .edu domain name. Employees, directors, officers of the Sponsor (including its affiliates and advertising agencies and sweepstakes administrators, and any third party organization Sponsor may be working with on the Sweepstakes, including Qzzr) and their immediate families (spouse, parents, children, siblings, and their respective spouses) and household members are not eligible to enter. This Sweepstakes is void where prohibited.
- **5. THE SWEEPSTAKES PERIOD.** The Sweepstakes begins on Thursday, September 1, 2016 and the winners will be announced on or about Monday, October 3, 2016, following Campus Fire Safety Month. The period for entering the Sweepstakes begins at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time (ET) on Thursday, September 1, 2016 and ends 11:59 p.m. ET on Friday, September 30, 2016 (the "Sweepstakes Entry Period").
- **6. HOW TO ENTER.** To enter the Sweepstakes, Participants must be eligible, must comply with these Official Rules, and must complete and submit the online quiz on cooking fire safety (8 questions, approximately 1 minute to complete), found at www.campusfiresafety.org/cooking during the Sweepstakes Entry Period. Entries will be accepted by using the Qzzr interactive quiz platform located at the above mentioned website. Participants will each receive one (1) sweepstakes entry for submitting a completed quiz and submitting their name, institute of higher education, a valid email address (using a .edu domain) and phone number. All Entries submitted, regardless of score received, will be given equal weight during the random drawing for winners. Once an Entry is submitted, it cannot be modified, changed or altered in any way for any reason. Participants may submit only a single Entry. Once entered in the Sweepstakes, it is solely the responsibility of each Participant to ensure the contact information we have for you is current. Sponsor is not responsible for any failure to contact you if the contact information is not current.

7. WINNER SELECTION. Two (2) winning entries will be randomly drawn from among all eligible entries. All decisions of the Sponsor, and its sweepstakes administrators are final.

SELECTION OF A WINNER DOES NOT INDICATE THE SPONSOR(S) HAVE ANY OPINION OF THE ACCURACY OF THE ANSWERS IN YOUR COMPLETED SUBMISSION.

8. PRIZE. Each winning Entry will receive a \$500USD American Express® gift card. In addition, the winners' names may be shared on the Sponsor's websites (www.campusfiresafety.org and www.nfpa.org) and promotional materials. Prizes are awarded "as is." No substitutions are allowed. Prizes will be awarded, provided a sufficient number of eligible entries are received. Prizes may not be transferred, substituted or redeemed for cash. Sweepstakes winners will not be compensated with a salary. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, elect to terminate, postpone or cancel the Sweepstakes at any time. Winning Participants will in addition have to accept certain rules and restrictions concerning the use of NFPA logos, messages and images and the rights of the NFPA.
