## CCFS Campus Fire Data Collection Project





Reason for the Data Project

Previously there had not a clearinghouse for campus fire data that encompasses the entire community:

- On Campus
- Off Campus
- Greek Housing
- Laboratory / Classroom





How it Came to Be

Funding was received from the Department of Homeland Security to start collecting fire data for campuses across the country



At the same time we looked at the requirements proposed under the *Campus Fire Safety Right to Know Act* 





How Will the Data Be Used?

Participation in this program will help the Center better identify the problems campuses face related to fire on campus.

From this data, the Center will be able to create new training programs that will help you mitigate the risk of fire on your campus.





Who Will use the Data?

This data will also help find creative new solutions to the issue of fire safety in the campus community:

- Fire Protection Engineers

Privacy and Security of Information

The data is secure and not available for others to see

Registered uses have the ability to run reports and measure their school statistics against the state, region or on a national level

The Center will also provide reports that show where problems are and from that find schools that are successfully solving problems and share their success stories with you





Who Should Participate?

There should only be one account to enter data for a campus.

The local department or off-campus AHJ should be included in a conversation so that all campus related fires are entered

If the fire department enters data, make sure the fires are not entered twice





What Type of Data is Collected?

- the number of fires and the cause of each fire
- the number of injuries related to a fire
- the number of deaths related to a fire
- the value of property damage caused by a fire
