



## The Center for Campus Fire Safety - Fire Fatality Data

From January 2000 to present

94 people have lost their lives in sixty-six separate campus related fires.

These fires occurred on a college campus, in Greek housing or in off-campus housing within 3-miles of the campus

- 54 fires have occurred in off-campus housing claiming 76 victims
- 6 fires have occurred in on-campus building or residence halls claiming 8 victims
- 6 fires have occurred in Greek housing claiming 10 victims

Of the 66 fires documented:

- 14 were intentionally set claiming 22 victims
- 29 were accidental - includes cooking, candles, smoking or electrical claiming 38 victims
- 23 of the fires the cause was never determined - or the cause was not available at press time. These fires claimed 34 victims.
